## Converting Bookshare Files to Kindle DX (text with images)

- 1. Convert the .xml to an .html
- 2. open the file in an internet browser
- 3. copied/pasted into a doc (I used Word for my test sample with a story about a bear, and Pages for the Reading Anthology)
- 4. (it took FOREVER to load as this was a huge document with images)
- 5. When converting the .doc (or .pages with Mac) to a PDF you may wish to break it up into sections
- 6. Once the PDFs are saved,
- 7. Use Calibre to convert them into MOBIs.

Alternately you can:

- save the xml format of the document in Word
- upload to pdf escape
- use mobiconverter to convert to kindle format.
- As long as the daisy comes with images, we have been able to successfully download them.
